- ✚ Institute for Advanced Studies on Asia (IASA), University of Tokyo, and College of Humanities, Arts, and Social Sciences (CoHASS), Nanyang Technological University will be co-hosting 1st International Joint Workshop on March 24, 2023 (Fri) at Nanyang Technological University.
- ✚ IASA established Global Asian Studies (GAS) program in 2022 to promote an “inside-out” approach to Asian studies. This approach respects the agency of local scholarship to determine what should be studied, while engaging with global audience.
